Did you know???

At Dania Home your loved one's safety is one of our top priorities.

Staff have regular training on nationally recognized healthcare codes. These codes indicate to staff on what procedures they are to follow depending on the situation. We recently had a Code Green with residents and staff participating in a full evacuation of the building. An evacuation of the building could be for many reasons, but combined with our Code Red it was an excellent way to get our residents to the evacuation points throughout the building. Code Red drills (fire) are held on each shift every month and all staff have to participate in at least two per year.

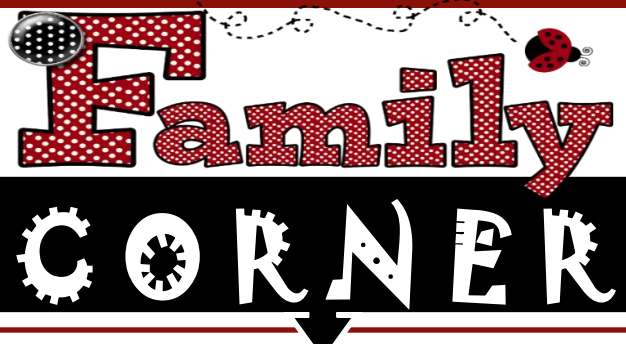

Quality Initiatives and Projects

- A recent review of medication delivery revealed that we are potentially using over 300 disposable plastic teaspoons to deliver crushed medications per day to our residents. Adding up the numbers, that's over 100,000 per year to the landfill. These teaspoons have to meet certain criteria and a project was undertaken to find a suitable alternative. Working with one of our suppliers we have been able to source a compostable spoon that meets our criteria. These spoons actually have a “shelf life” and then they start to naturally decompose, whether they are used or not. At a recent regional meeting, this initiative was discussed, and we are now looking at bringing our initiative to the provincial level.
