Dania Visitor Pandemic Safety Plan

We welcome you to visit your loved one with the following stipulations:

*“Due to the ongoing risk level in the Lower Mainland, Fraser Health continues to require you to allow **essential visitors only for actively dying residents/tenants (and only one essential visitor at a time)** -- at Long-Term Care (LTC), Private Hospitals and Assisted Living (AL) sites.”*
(Fraser Health and Ministry of Health, 2020.)

- When you enter Dania to visit, you will be assessed to ensure that you are well,
- Frequent hand hygiene is required as well as social distancing (minimum 6 feet) from all staff and/or residents,
- You will need to wear full protective personal equipment including: gown, mask, gloves,
- You must be accompanied by a staff member directly to your loved one's room and when your visit is over, you will be accompanied back to the exit,
- You cannot enter Dania on your own and you cannot enter any other room, including staff offices,
- You must remain in your loved one's room for your entire visit and use the bedside call bell to contact staff when you are ready to leave,
- You are not responsible for any care for your loved one; the staff will provide care,
- If staff are providing care, you will be asked to wait in the resident's washroom or by the door (inside the room),
- You are not allowed to Facetime, video or take photographs when any staff are in the room and/or providing care,

If you do not follow the above guidelines, you will be escorted off site and will not be allowed to visit. Our priority must be all Dania residents, staff and family safety.

We will continue to support Dania residents and loved ones' connections through Skype, phone and/or through the window. We appreciate your patience with these difficult times and your support in ensure safety for all Dania's residents and staff.
