TIPS TO PREVENT SLIPS ON SNOW AND ICE

CLEAR WALKWAYS
of snow and ice, and spread deicer as quickly as possible

WEAR PROPER FOOTWEAR
when walking on snow or ice. A pair of insulated and water-resistant boots with good rubber treads is a must for walking during or after a winter storm. Keeping a pair of rubber overshoes with good treads that fit over your street shoes is a good idea during the winter months.

TAKE SHORT STEPS
and walk at a slower pace so you can react quickly to a change in traction.
